FARMERSVILLE MARKET POLICIES

Farmersville Chamber of Commerce

The Farmersville Market (formerly Farmers & Fleas) is held the first Saturday of each month, at the Historic Onion Shed and in the surrounding field spaces.

The Farmersville Chamber of Commerce took over the Farmers & Fleas Market as of August 2020 and will continue the same tradition (since 2004) of creating opportunities for tourism and commerce at this market and in Farmersville. *NOTE: We will be making some changes; adding some perks, bringing more people together and creating spectacular holiday markets in the future.*

All vendors must follow the policies set by the Farmersville Chamber of Commerce. Vendors must follow pertinent federal, state and local laws and ordinances; and they must exhibit appropriate vendor behavior. Failure to follow rules may result in loss of the privilege to be a Farmers and Fleas Market vendor. All products sold at the market are subject to applicable local health and state/federal licensing and taxing regulations, and the burden of compliance is individually placed on each Market vendor.

Vendors are required to have their state sales tax permit, to apply call 1-800-252-5555 or the application can be found online at www.window.state.tx.us/taxpermit/

- **Vendors set up no earlier than 7am and no later than 8:30am. Cars will not be allowed in the loading areas after 8:45am.**
- **If a vendor has not checked in by 8:30am, the space will be resold if needed.**
- **Market Open hours are from 9am – 3pm. Vendors must remain in their spaces until 3pm.**
- **No animals or firearms may be sold at the Farmers and Fleas Market. No political vendors.**

Food Vendors

- Must have submitted a current Texas State Food Permit with their application to be a vendor.
- Food Vendors must have one of these state health permits: Food Vendors set up in the park on the grass on the east side.
 - Temporary Food Establishment Permit
 - Roadside Food Vendor/Mobile Food Unit Permit
- Non-Profit 501 (c) organizations are exempt from permits but must complete application and pay the Market fees.

Vendor spots are not reserved until paid in full with a completed form. NO REFUNDS

- The Chamber Staff or their designee will assign spaces.
- The Chamber Staff reserves the right to deny vendors if their products closely match another vendor.
- On-Site registrations will be assigned to paid vendors as space allows.

Tables/Chairs: Vendors provide your own tables/chairs unless rental arrangements have been made in advance through the Chamber.

Use of the Grounds and Onion Shed: No permanent alterations may be made to the grounds or to the Onion Shed. **No smoking in the Onion Shed.** No alcoholic beverages in the Onion Shed or on the grounds. No gas or electric heaters in the Onion Shed.

Please keep your sales area clean! Use the trash cans!

You are responsible for cleaning up your area after the market is over. If your space is left unclean we reserve the right to suspend your attendance in future market dates.

Liabilities: In and for the consideration of the use of the property, sellers shall hold the city, the Chamber and landowners harmless for any claims or other liabilities in any way associated with the association's use of the property.

Parking and Loading (our staff will not be able to assist in loading and unloading):

- *If your space is in the Onion Shed:* please drive up close to the Onion Shed on the appropriate side to unload, and then move your car to park it. During loading and unloading we treat the roads next to the shed as one way- enter from Main Street. After the market, please pack your items first, and then bring your car to load. This will help us to move cars in and out quickly.
- *Free parking* is available on city streets and in nearby city parking lots.

Public Restrooms: Are available in city park on the south side of the Onion Shed.

Vendor forms are available on the Chamber website: www.farmersvillechamber.com or from the Chamber office at 201 S. Main Street. (Call ahead if you will be picking up the form at 972-782-6533).

Be prepared for weather as this is an outdoor market. You may bring a canopy or tarp to protect your space.

There are gaps in the floor planks under the Onion Shed. You are encouraged to bring a rug to cover the floor in your space. If an item falls under the shed between the planks, we will attempt to retrieve it for you, but we cannot be responsible for lost items.

Electricity limited to 20 amps. No electric heaters can be used under the Onion Shed.

Onion Shed Location: 151 South Main Street (south of the intersection of Main and McKinney Streets, in downtown Farmersville).
